Code of Conduct Agreement

Student Rules of Conduct for Primary Classes (K-2)

This is the basic code of conduct that Heritage Classical Academy requires all primary class students to obey.

1. Students are expected to observe Christian standards of behavior and conversation. For example, students must speak honestly, respect their peers and submit to authority.
2. Prompt and cheerful obedience is expected.
3. Students must comply with the dress code in all respects.
4. In order to avoid litter and distraction, chewing gum, candy, etc. and electronic musical devices or games are not permitted.
5. Students are expected to be aware of and avoid the off-limit areas of the building and school/church property. Students should not play on or around cars in the parking lot.
6. Running is not allowed in the building.
7. Students are expected to treat all class materials and facilities with respect and care.
8. Students are expected to treat one another with kindness and respect.
9. Students are expected to treat prayer and class discussion with proper reverence.
10. Any home assignments missed, as a result of absence, should be completed in the timeframe set forth by the teacher.
11. Students accept responsibility to complete all homework assignments.
12. Students recognize that they are to be held responsible for their conduct, both in action and attitude, by their parents, teachers and those in authority at Heritage Classical Academy.
