Our students prepare to become solid readers through studying phonics, and jump start their handwriting skills through copy work. Copy work is based on Scripture verses in order to develop both their writing and engrain the Truth in their hearts! We incorporate reading out loud into our classroom time, including the titles you see below. Our students also begin to develop their math skills using Saxon I, a curriculum which thoroughly cements basic math skills for continued success in school.

Our students study art, create projects and crafts, learn about the world around them, enjoy snack, lunch, and recess, and begin to build a foundation to become lifelong learners. Some of their creative projects include creating a sunrise like the famous artist Monet using tissue paper, or mapping out animals of the world on a large wall map!
